A decision will be made by 5:30AM whenever possible, unless conditions are changing, requiring delays or changes. Please remember that the weather requires the school administrator to make very difficult decisions involving closings and delays. The decision cannot be made sometimes until the last minute.

Delays: Occasionally there may be a school opening delay for one or two hours. A delay allows the road surfaces to warm and allows for the onset of daylight.

Early Dismissal: An early dismissal is possible if unexpected snow or ice begins during the school day and we feel that students need to get home before the roads are to hazardous for travel. Working parents make sure you have a plan in place in the event that we need to dismiss early.

Make-up Days: If we need to make up snow days they will be scheduled for February 20th, March 3rd, April 14th, and June 2nd

Decision: You can be sure we will make the school closing decision based on all the available information given to us. However, we must deal with varying conditions and sudden weather changes. There may be times that we will err on the side of safety for students and staff members. Please try to be patient with us. One of our greatest concerns is that a student might get hurt in an accident on an icy road.
